Description	The Chisago SWCD Resource Conservationist (Jason Rehn) will inventory active gully erosion sites along the St. Croix River escarpment from the entrance to Wild River State Park near Almelund, MN, continuing south to the Chisago County line. The resulting inventory will be utilized to contact landowners with actively eroding gully sites on their property and will begin the process of developing a plan to implement Best Management Practices (BMPs) to correct the problems. This project is important for several reasons. First, identifying gully sites and implementing BMPs to stop active erosion will reduce phosphorus loading to the St. Croix River by hundreds of pounds per year. Water will be collected and infiltrated onsite, which will drastically reduce the amount of phosphorus and sediment entering the St. Croix River. In addition, the St. Croix escarpment is home to many rare and native species. The continued erosion of this area causes degradation to the habitat of these species. By stabilizing the area, the rare and native plant and animal species will continue to thrive in their natural environment. The St. Croix River itself is also home to rare species, including native mussels. These organisms will benefit from the reduction in phosphorus and sediment reaching the St. Croix River.

Actual Results	The following activities have been conducted to date, August 10, 2011: The Chisago SWCD conducted a desktop analysis that includes an Arcmap GIS survey of potential gullies within the St. Croix River escarpment project area. There were two types of gullies identified and indicated on the maps using shapefiles, larger (427) and smaller (193). Criteria was developed to differentiate larger gullies from the smaller ones, such as length (>500') and size. A querry was done to create a mailing to those landowners that have potential gullies, asking permission to enter their property to view the area. Aerial photo maps, with the shapefiles and landowner permissions, have been created to to assist in conducting the field survey.			
	As of 12/31/11 The field inventory has been completed. All total 618 gullies were identified and 494 were field varified. The gullies that were not field checked was because the landowner did not allow the SWCD access to their property. Of the 494 gullies field checked, 112 gullies were identified as activiely eroding. A total of 36 gullies were ranked as severly eroding from the list of 112. Our office is currently in the process of writing the final report for this project. As of 4/20/12
