The City of North Branch received funding to stabilize the shoreline along the North Branch of the Sunrise River within the park and to treat and filter storm water runoff before it enters the river. Through the use of clean water diversions, water bars, stabilizing inlets and outlets, and critical area seeding this portion of the river is stable and will provide filtered, cleaner water for the river which benefits fish and wildlife habitat and will reduce the amount of contaminants entering the stream.
