

PENINSULA AVENUE RAIN GARDENS— LINDSTROM, MN

The projects on Peninsula Avenue are located within a high-priority subwatershed identified by the Subwatershed Assessment for Lindstrom. Two rain gardens were installed in 2013. Runoff water used to drain directly into North Center Lake without treatment via a culvert and storm drain system.

One rain garden is located near the top of the watershed, at the intersection of Olinda Trail North and Peninsula Avenue. The other rain garden is at the bottom of the hill on Peninsula Avenue. The two gardens together capture stormwater runoff and allow it to infiltrate into the ground.
