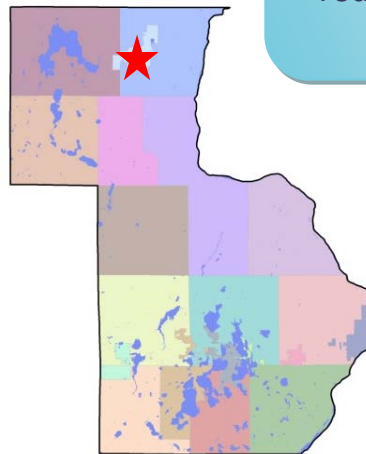


WEST 7TH STREET NEIGHBORHOOD

RAIN GARDENS



Six interested landowners agreed to install a curb-cut rain garden on their property. The Chisago SWCD and the City of Rush City worked together during the road reconstruction to include rain gardens in the project. These gardens help capture stormwater runoff that would otherwise enter Rush Creek to the north untreated. These rain gardens were strategically placed in the neighborhood to collect and treat the most stormwater possible in the space available. Each homeowner maintains their unique rain garden and can add their own personality to them.
