- *~**BALSAM FIR** (*Abies balsamea*) Moderate growth rate, soils-sand through clay loam, full sun to shade. Mature height 50-75'.
- #~**NORWAY SPRUCE** (*Picea abies*) Fastest growing spruce, soils-sandy loam through clay in full sun. Mature height 80' tall.
- *~**WHITE SPRUCE** (*Picea glauca*) Moderate growth rate, sandy loam to clay in sun through shade. Mature height 50-75' tall.
- #~**BLACK HILLS SPRUCE** (*Picea glauca densata*) Moderate growth rate, soils-loamy sand through clay, will tolerate full to partial sun. Mature height 30-50' tall.
- *~**RED (Norway) PINE** (*Pinus resinosa*) Minnesota State Tree. Fast growing, soils-sand through silty loam, and full to partial sun. Mature height 75-100' tall.
- *~**WHITE PINE** (*Pinus strobus*) Fast growing, soils-loamy sand through clay loam, and full to partial sun. Mature height 75-100'.
- #~**TAMARACK/AMERICAN LARCH** (*Larix laricina*) Fast growing, soils sand through clay, full sun. deciduous conifer (has light green needles in summer and a brilliant yellow color in fall then needles fall off). Can grow in saturated soil but no ponding. Mature height 50 – 80 ft.
- *~**WHITE CEDAR/AMER. ARBORVITE** (*Thuja occidentalis*) Moderate growth rate, soils-sandy loam through clay, and full to partial sun. Mature height 30-60' tall.
- *~**HACKBERRY** (*Celtis occidentalis*) Fast growing, soils sandy loam to silty clay, full to partial sun. Medium to large tree with nice form. Has bright yellow fall color. Grows in many different moisture regimes. Mature height 50 – 75 ft.
- *~**SILVER MAPLE** (*Acer saccharinum*) Very fast growing, soils- sand through clay, full sun to part shade. Mature height 60-80'.
- *~**SUGAR MAPLE** (*Acer saccharum*) Moderate growth rate, soils-sandy loam through silty loam, and full sun to shade. Has bright green leaves that turn yellow to scarlet in the fall. Mature height 50-75' tall.
- *~**RED MAPLE** (*Acer rubrum*) Fast growing, prefers sand through clay and does well in sun to partial shade. Fall foliage usually red but may be yellow or orange. Grows 50 to 70 feet tall.
- *~**RED OAK** (*Quercus rubra*) Moderate growth rate, soils-sandy loam through clay, and full to partial sun. Dark green leaves that turn red in fall. Mature height 60-80'.
- #~**WHITE OAK** (*Quercus alba*) Slow growing, sand - clay, full sun to partial sun, very high wildlife rating. Height 75-100'.
- ~**POPLAR** (*Thevestina*) Very fast growing, soils-sand through clay, full to partial sun. Yellow fall foliage. Mature height 70-90' tall.
- #~**WHITE/PAPER BIRCH** (*Betula papyrifera*) Moderate growth rate, soils-sand - silty clay, and full to partial sun. White papery bark makes this a popular landscape tree. Yellow fall color. Mature height 50-70' tall.
- ~**GOLDEN WILLOW** (*Salix alba "Vitellina"*) Fast growing, upright tree with slightly drooping branches. Will grow in most soils, prefers moist sites, full sun to partial shade. Mature height 40-55' tall.
- #~**COMMON CHOKECHERRY** (*Prunus virginiana*) Fast growing, soils-sandy loam - silty clay, and full - partial sun. White spring flowers with orange fall foliage. Height 10-20' tall.
- *~**RIVER BIRCH** (*Betula nigra*) Fast growing, sand to clay, full to partial sun, does well in wetter site. Mature height 30-50'.
- *~**RED SPLENDOR CRABAPPLE** (*Malus 'Red Splendor'*) Moderate growth rate, soils-sandy loam through clay in full sun. Mature height 20-30'.
- ***AMERICAN PLUM** (*Prunus americana*) Moderate growth rate, soils -loamy sand through silty clay, and full sun. White flowers in the spring with yellow fall foliage. Height 10-30' tall.
- #**ROSA RUGOSA** (*Rosa rugosa*) Fast growing, soils sandy loam through clay loam, full sun. One of the most trouble-free roses, blooms all summer, fragrant, colors vary (red, white or pink), root suckers freely. Height 4-8'
- #**COMMON LILAC** (*Syringa vulgaris*) Moderate growth rate, soils- sandy loam through clay loam, & full sun. Green foliage, lavender spring flower, mature height 10-15' tall.
- ***REDOSIER DOGWOOD** (*Cornus stolonifera*) Fast growing shrub, soil- sand through clay, and full sun. Has medium to dark green leaves and red stems. Produces berries for wildlife and is good for wetter sites. Mature height 6-12' tall.
- ***AMERICAN HAZELNUT** (*Corylus americana*) Moderate growth rate, any soil type, and sun through shade. Mature height 6-8'.
- JUNEBERRY-Regent Serviceberry** (*Amelanchier alnifolia*) Moderate growth rate, soils-sand through sandy clay, and full sun to partial sun. High wildlife rating, produces an edible sweet fruit. Mature height 4-6' tall.
- NANKING CHERRY** (*Prunus tomentosa*) Moderate growth rate, soils -sandy loam through clay loam, and full sun to partial shade. Pinkish white flowers followed by red/yellow fruit. Widely used for jelly if not taken by birds. Mature height 6-8' tall.

SUPPLIES AVAILABLE:

Root Dip helps retain moisture preventing tree loss due to dry conditions. Mix with water & the roots are dipped into the mixture before planting.

Fertilizer one tablet is dropped in the hole at the time of planting. Nutrients are released slowly over a long period.

Marker Flags 25 brightly colored 36" flags used to mark and help you keep track of young trees in grassy areas.

Plantkydd deer and rabbit repellent. This blood meal-based product when sprayed on will help to deter deer and rabbits from nipping off young shoots for approximately 6 months.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Species over 15' at mature height should not be planted under power lines.
- Planting along roadways - remember to keep your trees out of the road right of way.
- All trees are bundled in quantities of twenty-five (25).
